Stroke in Australian Children under 2-years of age – Follow-up

BACKGROUND

Information on stroke in Australian children under 2-years of age has been collected via the Australian Paediatric Surveillance Unit between June 2017 and July 2019.

Follow up information on the previously notified cases of stroke is now being sought and will include: paediatrician, neonatologist and/or physiotherapist, General Movements (GMs), Hammersmith Infants Neurological Examination (HINE) and/or Growth and Developmental follow up reports.

STUDY OBJECTIVES

1. To follow up the outcome of stroke in Australian children <2 years of age

CASE DEFINITION

Please include the follow up reports from paediatrician, neonatologist and/or physiotherapist, General Movements (GMs), Hammersmith Infants Neurological Examination (HINE) and/or Growth and Development for cases of stroke you have previously notified.
