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The Association of Genetic Support of Australasia (AGSA) a tax-deductible registered charity, was formed in 1988 to provide peer support and information for individuals and families affected by a genetic condition. AGSA's client database is the largest in Australia and has over 850 rare genetic conditions and a rare chromosomal abnormality database of over 250 conditions represented. This equates to 10's 100's and 1000's of people. The diagnosis of a genetic condition in a family member particularly a child, places enormous stress on a family, and has pioneered the non-clinical approach to ease the burden of isolation they expereince..
